To repeal section 743.50 of the Revised Code to eliminate law authorizing the maintenance of buffers around municipal water reservoirs by contiguous property owners.

To amend section 145.011 of the Revised Code to include new nonteaching employees of The University of Akron as members in the Public Employees Retirement System and to make an appropriation for the University's School Employees Retirement System employer surcharge payments.
