INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

To amend section 1349.52 and to enact section 1349.521 of the Revised Code to enable the parents or guardian of a protected consumer to freeze that consumer's credit to protect the consumer from identity theft.

H. B. No. 318 - Representative Stinziano.

To enact sections 176.10, 176.11, and 176.12 of the Revised Code to create The Ohio Coordinating Committee to End Homelessness and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 319 - Representatives Anielski, LaTourette.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.876 of the Revised Code to create to the "Chagrin Falls Exempted Village Schools" license plate.

H. B. No. 320 - Representative Anielski.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.877 of the Revised Code to create the "Independence Local Schools" license plate.

H. B. No. 321 - Representative Anielski.

Cosponsor: Representative Dovilla.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.875 of the Revised Code to create the "North Royalton City Schools" license plate.

H. B. No. 322 - Representatives Anielski, Barnes.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.878 of the Revised Code to create the "Orange City Schools" license plate.

H. B. No. 323 - Representatives Anielski, Patmon.

Cosponsor: Representative Barnes.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact sections 4503.88, 4503.881,

4503.882, 4503.883, 4503.884, and 4503.885 of the Revised Code to provide for the issuance of public school district license plates and private school license plates.

H. B. No. 324 - Representative Ramos.

Cosponsors: Representatives Strahorn, Phillips, Brenner, Thompson, Terhar, Cera, Vitale, Leland, Perales, Johnson, G., Antonio, Bishoff, Lepore-Hagan, Green.

To enact section 5.255 of the Revised Code to declare November 23rd as Fleet Admiral Ernest Joseph King Day.
