**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 334** - Representative Buchy.

Cosponsors: Representatives Amstutz, Antonio, Barnes, Becker, Boyce, Bishoff, Curtin, Derickson, Dever, DeVitis, Hagan, Hall, Hood, LaTourette, Maag, Manning, Patmon, Perales, Retherford, Rezabek, Ruhl, Schaffer, Slaby, Sprague, Stinziano, Sykes, Thompson, Vitale.

To amend section 5739.01 of the Revised Code to exempt memberships to gyms or other recreational facilities operated by nonprofit organizations from sales and use taxation.

**H. B. No. 335** - Representatives Craig, Grossman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brenner, Becker, Smith, K., O'Brien, M., Boyce.

To amend sections 1901.20 and 1907.02 and to enact section 4511.072 of the Revised Code to specify the jurisdiction of municipal and county courts over municipal traffic ordinances and to establish requirements governing fines, fees, or other charges for traffic violations and infractions imposed by a municipal corporation that does not have the authority to establish a mayor's court.

**H. B. No. 336** - Representatives Dever, Ryan.

Cosponsors: Representatives Green, Hambley, Perales, Stinziano.

To amend section 1701.86 of the Revised Code to require, under certain circumstances, a certificate of dissolution of a corporation to be accompanied by an affidavit stating that the corporation is not required to pay or has not been assessed any taxes at the time of dissolution.

**H. B. No. 337** - Representative Clyde.

Cosponsors: Representatives Reece, Fedor, Sheehy, Ramos, Leland, Antonio, Lepore-Hagan.

To enact section 5.256 of the Revised Code to designate the fourth Tuesday of September as Ohio Voter Registration Day.

Said bills were considered the first time.
