To amend section 5739.121 of the Revised Code to allow vendors to deduct or apply for a refund of sales tax remitted for bad debts on private label credit cards used to make purchases from the vendor.

H. B. No. 405 - Representatives Schaffer, Smith, K.

To amend section 2907.07 of the Revised Code to amend the penalties for the offense of importuning.

H. B. No. 406 - Representative Burkley.

To enact section 5534.012 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of U.S. route 127 in Paulding County as the "U.S. Navy Petty Officer 2nd Class Randall Smith Memorial Highway."
