**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 419** - Representatives Sears, Ginter.

To amend section 3701.341 and to enact section 3701.3411 of the Revised Code regarding the disposition of fetal remains from abortions.

**H. B. No. 420** - Representative Roegner.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hayes, Henne, Bishoff, Becker, Conditt, Burkley, Ruhl, Buchy, Hood, Blessing, LaTourette, Phillips, Hambley, Fedor, Patterson, Vitale, Thompson, Brinkman, Koehler, Manning, Zeltwanger.

To amend sections 3302.01 and 3302.03 of the Revised Code to prohibit the Department of Education from including students who "opt-out" of state assessments in calculations of certain grades in the state report card and to declare an emergency.

**H. B. No. 421** - Representative LaTourette.

Cosponsors: Representatives Sprague, Koehler, Hambley, Sheehy.

To amend section 4729.01 and to enact sections 4729.45, 4730.412, and 4731.057 of the Revised Code to authorize a pharmacist to administer by injection certain prescribed drugs.

Said bills were considered the first time.
