INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 439 - Representative Anielski.

To amend sections 2907.08, 2907.321, 2907.322, 2907.323, and 2929.13 of the Revised Code to include an impaired person as a victim of voyeurism and to include conduct involving an impaired person within the offenses of pandering obscenity involving a minor, pandering sexually oriented matter involving a minor, and illegal use of a minor in a nudity-oriented material or performance.

H. B. No. 440 - Representative Anielski.

To enact section 5.48 of the Revised Code to designate the Saturday before Thanksgiving as "Ohio Survivors of Suicide Loss Day."

H. B. No. 441 - Representative McColley.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Blessing, Brenner, Buchy, Burkley, Hambley, Henne, Huffman, Koehler, Retherford, Sweeney, Thompson, Zeltwanger.

To amend section 3313.5311 and to enact section 3313.5314 of the Revised Code to permit a student enrolled in a nonpublic school to participate in interscholastic activities at a school district that is not the student's resident district under certain circumstances and to prohibit a student who participates in the College Credit Plus program from being denied the opportunity to participate in interscholastic athletics solely due to participation in the program.

H. B. No. 442 - Representatives O'Brien, S., O'Brien, M.

To enact section 5534.16 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 82 in Trumbull County as the "Lance Corporal Stanley J. Sliwinski Memorial Highway."
