The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Pelanda was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 447 - Representatives Schuring, Slesnick.

To amend section 2921.321 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person from intentionally killing a police dog in the line of duty.

H. B. No. 448 - Representative Cupp.

Cosponsors: Representatives Grossman, O'Brien, S., Duffey, Amstutz, Brown, Koehler, Zeltwanger, Sprague, Schaffer, Slaby, Burkley, Green, Ginter, Becker, Terhar, Fedor, Romanchuk.

To amend sections 109.57, 109.572, 109.60, and 2717.01 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person who has been convicted of an unsealable offense from changing the person's name and to require a court that is considering a name change application to obtain a criminal records check to determine whether the person is ineligible for the change.

H. B. No. 449 - Representatives Romanchuk, Amstutz.

Cosponsors: Representatives Thompson, Bishoff, Ruhl, Sprague, Antonio, Brenner, Sheehy, Reece, Ramos.

To enact section 5.256 of the Revised Code to designate February 3 as "Charles Follis Day."

H. B. No. 450 - Representatives Thompson, Hall.

To amend sections 9.62 and 721.15 of the Revised Code to authorize a law enforcement officer to purchase a police dog or horse for one dollar when the officer retires in good standing from a law enforcement agency and certain conditions are met.

H. B. No. 451 - Representative Boose.

Cosponsors: Representatives Pelanda, Grossman, Baker, Becker, Zeltwanger, Rogers.

To amend sections 2133.08, 2133.09, and 2133.12 of the Revised Code to provide that an individual's statutory priority to decide whether or not to withhold or withdraw life-sustaining treatment for the individual's relative is forfeited if the individual is the subject of a temporary protection order or civil protection order and the relative is the alleged victim or if the individual and the relative are married and the parties to a divorce, dissolution, legal separation, or annulment proceeding.

H. B. No. 452 - Representative Vitale.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Brinkman, Buchy, Hood, Young, Zeltwanger.

To amend sections 2923.122 and 2923.126 of the Revised Code to generally permit a concealed handgun licensee to carry a concealed handgun in a place of worship.

H. B. No. 453 - Representative Arndt.

Cosponsors: Representatives Grossman, Reineke, Boccieri, Terhar, Boose, Blessing, Schaffer, Romanchuk, Perales.

To enact section 5534.15 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 6 in Erie County as the "Army Specialist Dennis Ramon Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 454 - Representative Patterson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Rogers, O'Brien, M.

To amend sections 5739.02 and 5739.05 of the Revised Code to provide for a permanent three-day sales tax "holiday" each August during which sales of back-to-school clothing and school supplies are exempt from sales and use taxes.

H. B. No. 455 - Representatives Patterson, Roegner.

Cosponsors: Representatives O'Brien, M., Rogers.

To amend section 4511.21 of the Revised Code to authorize a municipal corporation or township to establish a boarding school zone and a special speed limit within that zone.

H. B. No. 456 - Representative Becker.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hood, Vitale, Henne, Antani, Brinkman.

To amend sections 3501.01, 3503.10, 3503.11, 3503.14, 3503.15, 3503.16, 3503.19, 3503.23, 3505.181, 3505.182, 3505.183, 3509.03, 3511.02, 3513.05, 3513.18, 3513.19, 3513.191, 3513.192, 3513.30, 3513.31, 3513.311, 3517.012, 3517.013, 3517.05, 3599.02, 3599.11, 3599.18, and 4507.06; to enact sections 3503.20, 3513.053, and 3513.054; to repeal sections 3513.20, 3517.014, and 3517.016 of the Revised Code; and to amend the version of

section 4507.06 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect January 1, 2017, to continue the provisions of this act on and after that effective date to revise the law concerning electors' political party affiliations, candidates for public office, and the removal of appointed political party central committee members.
