INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 521 - Representative Manning.

To amend sections 2929.02, 2929.14, 2967.13, 2971.03, and 5149.101 and to enact section 2967.132 of the Revised Code to provide special parole eligibility dates for persons with an indefinite or life sentence imposed for an offense committed when the person was less than 18 years of age, to require the Parole Board to consider specified mitigating factors in those cases, and to require notice to the Ohio Public Defender and prosecuting attorney prior to the parole consideration hearing.

H. B. No. 522 - Representative Phillips.

Cosponsors: Representatives Rogers, Smith, K.

To amend sections 1509.01, 1509.02, 1509.05, 1509.06, 1509.072, 1509.074, 1509.08, 1509.21, 1509.22, 1509.227, 6111.043, and 6111.046 and to enact section 1509.051 of the Revised Code to prohibit injection of brine and other waste substances except in class I injection wells, to prohibit the conversion of oil and gas wells, to require municipal or township approval prior to the issuance of an oil or gas well permit, and to levy a fee on the injection of brine and other waste substances into a class I injection well.

H. B. No. 523 - Representative Huffman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Schuring, Ramos.

To amend sections 109.572, 303.21, 519.21, 4123.54, 4729.75, 4729.80, 4729.81, 4729.82, 4729.83, 4729.84, 4729.85, and 4729.86 and to enact sections 3796.01, 3796.02, 3796.03, 3796.04, 3796.05, 3796.06, 3796.07, 3796.10, 3796.11, 3796.12, 3796.13, 3796.18, 3796.19, 3796.20, 3796.21, 3796.22, 3796.27, 3796.28, 3796.29, 3796.30, and 4729.771 of the Revised Code to authorize the use of marijuana for medical purposes and to establish the Medical Marijuana Control Program.

Said bills were considered the first time.
