INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 536 - Representative Fedor.

Cosponsors: Representatives Smith, K., Boyd, Patmon, Howse, Antonio, Sweeney, Celebrezze, Curtin, Boggs, Bishoff, Leland, Boyce, Craig, Driehaus, Kuhns, Reece, Sykes, Johnson, G., Strahorn, Ashford, Sheehy, Ramos, Lepore-Hagan, Boccieri, Rogers, O'Brien, S., O'Brien, M., Clyde, Phillips, Cera, Patterson, Butler, Ruhl.

To amend section 3353.07 of the Revised Code to require the Ohio Government Telecommunications Service to broadcast live, with video and audio content, all General Assembly committee meetings and to name this act the Wire the Statehouse Act.

H. B. No. 537 - Representative Hayes.

To amend sections 1901.14, 1907.18, 2101.27, 3101.05, 3101.08, 4111.17, and 4735.55 and to enact sections 3101.081, 3101.16, 3101.17, 3101.18, 4114.01, 4114.02, 4114.03, 4114.04, 4114.05, 4114.06, and 4114.07 of the Revised Code to make discrimination in housing or employment on the basis of sexual orientation an unlawful discriminatory practice; to provide specified protections for religious expression and beliefs about marriage, family, and sexuality; and to prohibit an elected official who solemnizes marriages from refusing to solemnize a marriage of two persons who have been granted a marriage license.

H. B. No. 538 - Representative Boyce.

To amend section 4503.03 of the Revised Code to require the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to adopt rules that establish a training program for deputy registrars and their employees regarding the proper issuance of driver's licenses that includes training on evaluating all types of documentation necessary for issuing a driver's license and a cultural competency component, and that establish an administrative penalty applicable to a deputy registrar that improperly denies a driver's license to an eligible applicant.

H. B. No. 539 - Representative Boyce.

To enact section 107.22 of the Revised Code to create the office for New Americans.

Mr. Speaker:

I am directed to inform the House of Representatives that the Senate has passed the following bills in which the concurrence of the House is requested:

Sub. S. B. No. 199 - Senators Uecker, Gardner

To amend sections 1547.69, 2923.11, 2923.12, 2923.121, 2923.122, 2923.123, 2923.126, 2923.16, and 2923.21 of the Revised Code to specify that an active duty member of the U.S. Armed Forces: (1) does not need a concealed handgun license to carry a handgun concealed if the member is carrying valid military identification and documentation of successful completion of specified firearms training; and (2) may be sold or furnished a handgun if the member has received specified firearms training.
