To amend sections 3513.301 and 3513.312 of the Revised Code to eliminate the requirement of holding a special election to fill a vacancy in a party nomination for the office of representative to Congress under certain circumstances.

H. B. No. 592 - Representative Merrin.

Cosponsors: Representatives Amstutz, Schaffer, Ryan, Smith, R.

To amend section 5726.01 of the Revised Code to subject small business investment companies to the commercial activity tax rather than the financial institutions tax.
