WHEREAS, The Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century	4

authorization bill that expires on May 31, 2015; and	6		
WHEREAS, Ohio has made great strides in meeting the goals	7		
of MAP-21 by implementing projects and programs throughout the	8

WHEREAS, Ohio is currently conducting 17 major	10		
transportation projects, including the modernization and			
reconstruction of various interstate highways; and	12		
WHEREAS, Ohio has 258,774 roadway lane miles, 44,766	13		
bridges, 13,941 of which are located on the state's highway	14		
system, 35 railroads operating over 5,290 miles of track, and	15		
4,207 miles of bikeway facilities; and	16		
WHEREAS, the construction and maintenance of Ohio's	17
