A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge Congress and the United States Department of	1
Energy to reverse the decision to terminate funding of	2
the American Centrifuge Program at the American

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, The Centrus Energy Corporation ("Centrus") is a	5
supplier of enriched uranium fuel; and	6
WHEREAS, Since 2002, Centrus has been developing and	7
demonstrating a highly efficient uranium enrichment gas	8
centrifuge technology called the American Centrifuge technology;	9
and	10
WHEREAS, The American Centrifuge technology is a	11
disciplined evolution of classified United States centrifuge	12
technology originally developed by the United States Department	13
of Energy that Centrus has improved through advanced materials,	14
updated electronics, and design enhancements based on highly	15
advanced computer modeling capabilities; and	16
WHEREAS, As part of its American Centrifuge Program,	17
Centrus is working to deploy its American Centrifuge technology	18
in its American Centrifuge Plant located in Piketon, Ohio, to	19
support United States energy and national security; and	20

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Energy has invested three billion dollars over ten years to develop the American Centrifuge technology; and

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Energy recently announced its decision to terminate funding for the American Centrifuge Program in Piketon, Ohio, effective October 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Terminating funding for the American Centrifuge Program will have an irreversible impact on future enrichment capability at the American Centrifuge Plant in Piketon, Ohio, and on the specialized workforce and the communities in and around Piketon, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, The decision of the United States Department of Energy will adversely affect the local economy in southern Ohio and will result in the loss of hundreds of thousands of dollars in income tax and sales tax revenues to local communities already experiencing high levels of unemployment; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That Congress and the United States Department of Energy are urged to reverse the decision to terminate funding for the American Centrifuge Program in Piketon, Ohio; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore and Secretary of the United States Senate, the United States Department of Energy, each member of the Ohio Congressional delegation, and the news media of Ohio. 21
