**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):**

WHEREAS, The Centrus Energy Corporation ("Centrus") is a
supplier of enriched uranium fuel; and

WHEREAS, Since 2002, Centrus has been developing and
demonstrating a highly efficient uranium enrichment gas
centrifuge technology called the American Centrifuge technology;
and

WHEREAS, The American Centrifuge technology is a
disciplined evolution of classified United States centrifuge
technology originally developed by the United States Department
of Energy that Centrus has improved through advanced materials,
updated electronics, and design enhancements based on highly
advanced computer modeling capabilities; and

WHEREAS, As part of its American Centrifuge Program,
Centrus is working to deploy its American Centrifuge technology
in its American Centrifuge Plant located in Piketon, Ohio, to
support United States energy and national security; and

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Energy has 21
invested three billion dollars over ten years to develop the 22
American Centrifuge technology; and 23

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Energy recently 24
announced its decision to terminate funding for the American 25
Centrifuge Program in Piketon, Ohio, effective October 1, 2015; 26
and 27

WHEREAS, Terminating funding for the American Centrifuge 28
Program will have an irreversible impact on future enrichment 29
capability at the American Centrifuge Plant in Piketon, Ohio, 30
and on the specialized workforce and the communities in and 31
around Piketon, Ohio; and 32

WHEREAS, The decision of the United States Department of 33
Energy will adversely affect the local economy in southern Ohio 34
and will result in the loss of hundreds of thousands of dollars 35
in income tax and sales tax revenues to local communities 36
already experiencing high levels of unemployment; now therefore 37
be it 38

RESOLVED, That Congress and the United States Department of 39
Energy are urged to reverse the decision to terminate funding 40
for the American Centrifuge Program in Piketon, Ohio; and be it 41
further 42

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives 43
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the 44
Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, 45
the President Pro Tempore and Secretary of the United States 46
Senate, the United States Department of Energy, each member of 47
the Ohio Congressional delegation, and the news media of Ohio. 48
