A RESOLUTION

Recognizing National Crime Victims' Rights Week in Ohio,
April 10-16, 2016.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 131st General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize April 10-16, 2016, as National Crime Victims' Rights Week in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, In an effort to increase public knowledge of, and pay tribute to, crime victims and survivors, National Crime Victims' Rights Week was first designated by the U.S. Congress in April of 1984, with commemorative legislation passed each year since. Americans are victims of more than 20 million crimes each year. Affecting individuals of all races and socio-economic backgrounds, these events have long-lasting repercussions, not only for victims and their families but also for communities and society as a whole; and

WHEREAS, Our system of justice is founded on the principle of "justice for all" citizens, and although our nation has worked to expand rights and services for victims of crime, we must continue to strive to ensure that these same protections are available for all members of our population. Victims with disabilities and mental illness, those who are teenagers or are elderly, and those who live in rural areas or have different ethnic backgrounds must be treated with dignity and respect, as must all crime victims and their families; and

WHEREAS, In order to prevent the escalation of crime in the future, it is vital for all concerned citizens to join in educating the general public, including potential offenders, about

the effects of crime and in developing a general consciousness 25
