A RESOLUTION

Recognizing Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month, November
2016.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 131st General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize November 2016 as Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, Pancreatic cancer is the fourth leading cause of cancer-related death in the United States. The pancreas secretes enzymes that aid digestion and hormones that help regulate the metabolism of sugars, and the survival rate of cancer in this part of the body has not improved substantially in approximately four decades. It is estimated that 46,420 people in the United States will be diagnosed with Pancreatic Cancer and nearly 40,000 patients will die from the disease; and

WHEREAS, With only a six percent survival rate of more than five years, pancreatic cancer has few defined risk factors, with only family history of the disease, age, diabetes, and smoking being known. Causing only vague symptoms such as abdominal or back pain, nausea, loss of appetite, weight loss, jaundice, changes in stool, and diabetes, this cancer has limited treatment options, and it is a leading cause of cancer death mostly because there are no detection tools to diagnose the disease in its early stages when surgical removal of the tumor is possible; and

WHEREAS, Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month can undoubtedly be a benefit to those who suffer from, or who are at risk for, pancreatic cancer, as well as to the families and friends of these individuals. This observance can offer them help, support, and

encouragement in the fight against this disease; therefore be it 25
