BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	

WHEREAS, The safe operation of freight and passenger trains is vital to commerce, and Ohio supports efforts to keep train operations safe in our state. It is imperative to ensure the safe movement of freight trains because freight trains transport time-sensitive commodities, as well as toxic and dangerous chemicals through all portions of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, For each tour of service, crew members on a freight train must rest in order to work the required twelve hours of continuous service. In addition, each crew member needs to rest because the crew member does not have the option or luxury of stopping at his or her discretion. Because crew members must operate a train according to sign indication signals that indicate the location of trains ahead and behind, crew members, while on duty, must be alert at all times; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Railroad Administration has published a notice of a proposed rule requiring trains to be operated by at least two crew members. The Administration believes that, while advancements in automated technology such as Positive

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Train Control systems improve railroad safety, they are not a	22
substitute for a train's crew members; and	23
WHEREAS, National studies show that train operations	24
require a minimum of two crew members on board to minimize the	25
likelihood of train-related accidents; and	26
WHEREAS, Americans show overwhelmingly bi-partisan support	27
of two-person train crews. More than 80% of those polled favor	28
mandating that trains be operated by a crew of at least two	29
qualified individuals; and	30
WHEREAS, Virtually all trains in North America are already	31
operated by crews of at least two individuals, making the	32
economic impact of the proposed rule minimal; now therefore be	33
