### A RESOLUTION

Honoring Richard L. Kortokrax on his retirement as the  
winningest boys basketball coach in Ohio.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General  
Assembly of Ohio are pleased to extend special recognition to  
Richard L. Kortokrax on the memorable occasion of his retirement  
as the Kalida High School boys basketball coach; and

WHEREAS, Dick Kortokrax is deserving of high praise, for in  
fifty-six years of coaching boys basketball, he has demonstrated  
remarkable integrity and dedication. Commencing his tenure at Fort  
Jennings High School in 1960, he became the coach at Ottoville  
High School two years later, winning five Putnam County League  
championships and being named PCL Coach of the Year five times in  
thirteen seasons, and he has been the coach at Kalida High School  
since 1974, winning twenty PCL, twenty-four sectional, ten  
district, and four regional championships and the 1981 Class A  
State Championship and being named PCL Coach of the Year twelve  
times. His overall 890-371 record makes him the all-time  
winningest boys basketball coach in the State of Ohio, and he was  
inducted into the 1999 Ohio High School Basketball Coaches  
Association, 2002 Naismith Memorial Basketball, and 2012 Ohio  
Basketball halls of fame; and

WHEREAS, During his career, Dick Kortokrax has not only  
encouraged each athlete to develop his talents to the fullest but  
also instilled in each a valuable sense of determination,  
perseverance, camaraderie, and spirit. Due largely to his tireless  
efforts, his players have emerged as winners, both in and out of  
athletic competition, and we applaud him on his tremendous work;

WHEREAS, Dick Kortokrax's exceptional record of personal and

professional achievement stands as a hallmark worthy of emulation, 28  
and he has inspired countless individuals to excel in numerous 29  
areas of endeavor. His accomplishments and leadership are a 30
