### A RESOLUTION

Honoring Kyle Snyder on winning a gold medal at the 2016  
Summer Olympics.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General

placing first in the 97-kilogram division of freestyle wrestling  
at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio de Janeiro; and

WHEREAS, This achievement is truly noteworthy, for Kyle  
Snyder has clearly demonstrated his talent and perseverance, as  
well as his mental and physical fortitude as a wrestler. He won  
the 97-kilogram division of freestyle wrestling at this year's  
Summer Olympics by defeating a tough Khetag Goziumov of Azerbaijan  
by a score of 2-1, and he is the youngest American wrestler to
