## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month, November 2016.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 131st General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to recognize November 2016 as Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month; and 3 WHEREAS, The seventh most common cause of cancer deaths worldwide, pancreatic cancer kills 330,000 people annually, but 5 like many types of cancer, there are preventable actions individuals can take to reduce their chance of developing the disease. Educating the population about the danger pancreatic 8 cancer presents and taking steps to help eliminate those risk factors is at the heart of Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month; and 10 WHEREAS, What once seemed like a death sentence only a 11 generation ago has now become a fighting chance, and it is through 12 efforts such as Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month that we can 13 improve those odds even further. With only an overall one-year 14 survival rate of twenty percent and a five-year rate of seven 15 percent, the outlook may seem grim, but the rate increases the 16 earlier it is caught. We hope that by recognizing this month, we 17 can help people catch the warning signs earlier and increase their 18 chances of survival; and 19 WHEREAS, As cancer research has become more prominent and 20 wide-spread in recent years, undertakings such as this are a great 21 benefit to remind patients that there is still hope and that they 22 are never alone. Taking the month of November to educate the 23 community about the fight against pancreatic cancer is undoubtedly 24

a worthy endeavor, and it will help us forge a cancer-free future;
