A BILL

To enact section 5534.93 of the Revised Code to 1
designate a portion of State Route 73 in Warren 2
County as the "Officer Bill Johnson Memorial 3
Highway." 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5534.93 of the Revised Code be 5
enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 5534.93. In addition to any other name prescribed in 7
the Revised Code or otherwise, the portion of state route number 8
seventy-three, running in an easterly and westerly direction 9
between the intersection of state route number seventy-three and 10
state route number seven hundred forty-one and the intersection 11
of state route number seventy-three and interstate route number 12
seventy-five in Warren county only, shall be known as the 13

"Officer Bill Johnson Memorial Highway." 14

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 15
along the highway indicating its name. 16
