# A BILL

To amend sections 3333.38 and 3345.32 and to enact	1
section 3333.125 of the Revised Code to	2
establish the Commercial Truck Driver Student	3
Aid program and to make an appropriation.	4

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3333.38 and 3345.32 be amended	5
and section 3333.125 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as	6
follows:	7
Sec. 3333.125. (A) As used in this section:	8
(1) "Eligible student" means an individual who satisfies	9
all of the following:	10
(a) The individual is an Ohio resident.	11
(b) The individual has an expected family contribution of	12
two thousand one hundred ninety or less.	13
(c) The individual is enrolled in a certified commercial driver's license school.	14 15
(d) The individual has passed a drug test.	16

(e) The individual does not have more than three moving	17
violations in two consecutive years. If an individual who the	18
chancellor of higher education has determined is an eligible	19
student has three moving violations in two consecutive years	20
while participating in the program, the individual shall no	21
longer be considered eligible for continued participation in the	22
program.	23
<u>(f) The individual has not plead quilty to or been</u>	24
convicted of operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol	25
or a drug of abuse under section 4511.19 of the Revised Code in	26
the past twelve months. If an individual who the chancellor has	27
determined is an eligible student pleads guilty to or is	28
convicted of operating a vehicle under the influence of alcohol_	29
or a drug of abuse while participating in the program, the	30
individual shall no longer be considered eligible for continued	31
participation in the program.	32
(2) "Contified commencial driver to licence echecil" means a	2.2
(2) "Certified commercial driver's license school" means a	33 34
commercial driver's license school certified by the chancellor.	
The chancellor shall adopt requirements for approval of	35 36
certification and review applications based on those	
requirements.	37
No commercial driver's license school that charges	38
employers recruiting fees shall be certified under this	39
division.	40
<u>A certified driver's license program offered by a career</u>	41
college in this state that holds a certificate of registration	42
from the state board of career colleges and schools under	43
Chapter 3332. of the Revised Code or at a private institution	44
exempt from regulation under Chapter 3332. of the Revised Code_	45
as prescribed in section 3333.046 of the Revised Code shall be	46

considered a certified commercial driver's license school. 47 (3) "Cost of attendance" and "expected family\_ 48 contribution" shall be defined by the chancellor. 49 (4) "Moving violation" has the same meaning as in section 50 4510.01 of the Revised Code. 51 (B) The commercial truck driver student aid program is 52 hereby established. Under the program, the chancellor of higher 53 education shall pay to an eligible student a combination of a 54 grant and a loan in the amounts prescribed by division (D) of 55 this section to pay for the costs of a commercial driver's 56 license program at a certified commercial driver's license 57 school. 58 (C) There is hereby established in the state treasury the 59 commercial truck driver student aid fund, which shall consist of 60 funds appropriated by the general assembly for purposes of this 61 section and funds received as repayment for loans awarded under\_ 62 this section. 63 The fund shall be used by the chancellor for grants and 64 loans made under this section and for expenses of administering 65 the program. 66 (D) (1) The grant amount awarded to an eligible student 67 shall equal one-half of the student's remaining state cost of 68

attendance after the student's Pell grant and expected family69contribution are applied to the instructional and general70charges for the student's enrollment in the certified commercial71driver's license school.72

Except as provided in divisions (D)(2) and (E) of this73section, the chancellor also shall award a loan to an eligible74student in the same amount.75

(2) If, for any academic year, the amounts available for	76
support of the program are inadequate to provide grants and	77
loans to all eligible students who apply for participation or	78
are participating in the program, the chancellor shall	79
proportionately reduce the amount of each grant and loan to be	80
awarded for the academic year.	81
(E) The amount of a grant and a loan awarded to an	82
eligible student under this section shall be in addition to what	83
the eligible student receives under the Ohio college opportunity	84
grant under section 3333.122 of the Revised Code.	85
If an eligible student receives a grant under section	86
3333.122 of the Revised Code, the chancellor shall decrease the	87
amount of the eligible student's loan under this section by the	88
amount of the grant received under that section.	89
(F) The chancellor shall adopt rules, in accordance with	90
Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, necessary for the operation of	91
the program, including rules for both:	92
(1) Terms and conditions for loans under the program;	93
(2) Requirements for certification of commercial driver's	94
license schools.	95
Sec. 3333.38. (A) As used in this section:	96
(1) "Institution of higher education" includes all of the	97
following:	98
(a) A state institution of higher education, as defined in	99
section 3345.011 of the Revised Code;	100
(b) A nonprofit institution issued a certificate of	101
authorization under Chapter 1713. of the Revised Code;	102
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(c) A private institution exempt from regulation under
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Chapter 3332. of the Revised Code, as prescribed in section
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3333.046 of the Revised Code;
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(d) An institution of higher education with a certificate
of registration from the state board of career colleges and
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schools under Chapter 3332. of the Revised Code.
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(2) "Student financial assistance supported by state 109 funds" includes assistance granted under sections 3315.33, 110 3333.12, 3333.122, <u>3333.125,</u> 3333.21, 3333.26, 3333.28, 111 3333.372, 3333.391, 5910.03, 5910.032, and 5919.34 of the 112 Revised Code, financed by an award under the choose Ohio first 113 scholarship program established under section 3333.61 of the 114 Revised Code, or financed by an award under the Ohio co-115 op/internship program established under section 3333.72 of the 116 Revised Code, and any other post-secondary student financial 117 assistance supported by state funds. 118

(B) An individual who is convicted of, pleads guilty to,
or is adjudicated a delinquent child for one of the following
violations shall be ineligible to receive any student financial
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assistance supported by state funds at an institution of higher
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education for two calendar years from the time the individual
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applies for assistance of that nature:

(1) A violation of section 2917.02 or 2917.03 of the 125 Revised Code; 126

(2) A violation of section 2917.04 of the Revised Code127that is a misdemeanor of the fourth degree;128

(3) A violation of section 2917.13 of the Revised Code
that is a misdemeanor of the fourth or first degree and occurs
within the proximate area where four or more others are acting
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in a course of conduct in violation of section 2917.11 of the	132
Revised Code.	133
(C) If an individual is convicted of, pleads guilty to, or	134
is adjudicated a delinquent child for committing a violation of	135
section 2917.02 or 2917.03 of the Revised Code, and if the	136
individual is enrolled in a state-supported institution of	137
higher education, the institution in which the individual is	138
enrolled shall immediately dismiss the individual. No state-	139
supported institution of higher education shall admit an	140
individual of that nature for one academic year after the	141
individual applies for admission to a state-supported	142
institution of higher education. This division does not limit or	143
affect the ability of a state-supported institution of higher	144
education to suspend or otherwise discipline its students.	145
Sec. 3345.32. (A) As used in this section:	146
(1) "State university or college" means the institutions	147
described in section 3345.27 of the Revised Code and the	148
northeast Ohio medical university.	149
(2) "Resident" has the meaning specified by rule of the	150
chancellor of higher education.	151
(3) "Statement of selective service status" means a	152
statement certifying one of the following:	153
(a) That the individual filing the statement has	154
registered with the selective service system in accordance with	155
the "Military Selective Service Act," 62 Stat. 604, 50 U.S.C.	156
App. 453, as amended;	157
(b) That the individual filing the statement is not	158
required to register with the selective service for one of the	159
following reasons:	160

(i) The individual is under eighteen or over twenty-six 161 years of age. 162 (ii) The individual is on active duty with the armed 163 forces of the United States other than for training in a reserve 164 or national guard unit. 165 (iii) The individual is a nonimmigrant alien lawfully in 166 the United States in accordance with section 101 (a)(15) of the 167 "Immigration and Nationality Act," 8 U.S.C. 1101, as amended. 168 (iv) The individual is not a citizen of the United States 169 and is a permanent resident of the Trust Territory of the 170 Pacific Islands or the Northern Mariana Islands. 171 (4) "Institution of higher education" means any eligible 172 institution approved by the United States department of 173 education pursuant to the "Higher Education Act of 1965," 79 174 Stat. 1219, as amended, or any institution whose students are 175 eligible for financial assistance under any of the programs 176 described by division (E) of this section. 177 (B) The chancellor shall, by rule, specify the form of 178

statements of selective service status to be filed in compliance 179 with divisions (C) to (E) of this section. Each statement of 180 selective service status shall contain a section wherein a male 181 student born after December 31, 1959, certifies that the student 182 has registered with the selective service system in accordance 183 with the "Military Selective Service Act," 62 Stat. 604, 50 184 U.S.C. App. 453, as amended. For those students not required to 185 register with the selective service, as specified in divisions 186 (A) (2) (b) (i) to (iv) of this section, a section shall be 187 provided on the statement of selective service status for the 188 certification of nonregistration and for an explanation of the 189 reason for the exemption. The chancellor may require that such 190 statements be accompanied by documentation specified by rule of 191 the chancellor. 192

(C) A state university or college that enrolls in any
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course, class, or program a male student born after December 31,
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1959, who has not filed a statement of selective service status
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with the university or college shall, regardless of the
student's residency, charge the student any tuition surcharge
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charged students who are not residents of this state.

(D) No male born after December 31, 1959, shall be 199 eligible to receive any loan, grant, scholarship, or other 200 financial assistance for educational expenses granted under 201 section 3315.33, 3333.12, 3333.122, <u>3333.125, 3</u>333.21, 3333.22, 202 3333.26, 3333.391, 5910.03, 5910.032, or 5919.34 of the Revised 203 Code, financed by an award under the choose Ohio first 204 scholarship program established under section 3333.61 of the 205 Revised Code, or financed by an award under the Ohio co-206 op/internship program established under section 3333.72 of the 207 Revised Code, unless that person has filed a statement of 208 209 selective service status with that person's institution of higher education. 210

(E) If an institution of higher education receives a 211 statement from an individual certifying that the individual has 212 registered with the selective service system in accordance with 213 the "Military Selective Service Act," 62 Stat. 604, 50 U.S.C. 214 App. 453, as amended, or that the individual is exempt from 215 registration for a reason other than that the individual is 216 under eighteen years of age, the institution shall not require 217 the individual to file any further statements. If it receives a 218 statement certifying that the individual is not required to 219

register because the individual is under eighteen years of age, 220 the institution shall require the individual to file a new 221 statement of selective service status each time the individual 222 seeks to enroll for a new academic term or makes application for 223 a new loan or loan guarantee or for any form of financial 224 assistance for educational expenses, until it receives a 225 226 statement certifying that the individual has registered with the selective service system or is exempt from registration for a 227 reason other than that the individual is under eighteen years of 228 229 age.

Section 2. That existing sections 3333.38 and 3345.32 of the Revised Code are hereby repealed.

Section 3. All items in this section are hereby 232 appropriated as designated out of any moneys in the state 233 treasury to the credit of the designated fund. For all 234 appropriations made in this act, those in the first column are 235 for fiscal year 2018 and those in the second column are for 236 fiscal year 2019. The appropriations made in this act are in 237 addition to any other appropriations made for the FY 2018-FY 238 2019 biennium. 239

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The foregoing appropriation item 235517, Commercial Truck247Driver Student Aid Program, shall be used to provide grants and248loans under the Commercial Truck Driver Student Aid Program249established in section 3333.125 of the Revised Code.250

Of the foregoing appropriation item 235517, Commercial251Truck Driver Student Aid Program, up to \$2,500,000 in fiscal252year 2018 shall be distributed by the Chancellor of Higher253Education as grants pursuant to section 3333.125 of the Revised254Code.255

Of the foregoing appropriation item 235517, Commercial256Truck Driver Student Aid Program, up to \$2,500,000 in fiscal257year 2018 shall be distributed by the Chancellor of Higher258Education as loans pursuant to section 3333.125 of the Revised259Code.260

Section 4. Within the limits set forth in this act, the 261 Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 262 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 263 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 264 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 265 from appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for 266 as though made in the main operating appropriations act of the 267 132nd General Assembly. 268

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all 269 provisions of the main operating appropriations act of the 132nd 270 General Assembly that are generally applicable to such 271 appropriations. 272
