BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3513.301 and 3513.312 of the	7
Revised Code be amended to read as follows:	8
Sec. 3513.301. (A) Notwithstanding section 3513.30 of the	9
Revised Code and except as otherwise provided in division (B)(2)	10
