## A BILL

To amend section 4503.21 of the Revised Code to	1
authorize the owner or operator of a specialty	2
kit car to display a license plate only on the	3
rear of the car if the owner or operator pays a	4
\$150 fee.	5

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4503.21 of the Revised Code be	6
amended to read as follows:	7
Sec. 4503.21. (A) (1) No person who is the owner or	8
operator of a motor vehicle shall fail to display in plain view	9
on the front and rear of the motor vehicle <u>a license plate that</u>	10
bears the distinctive number and registration mark assigned to	11
the motor vehicle by the director of public safety, including	12
any county identification sticker and any validation sticker	13
issued under sections 4503.19 and 4503.191 of the Revised Code,	14
furnished by the director of public safety, except that a as	15
follows:	16

(a) A manufacturer of motor vehicles or dealer therein, 17

the holder of an in transit permit, and the owner or operator of18a motorcycle, motorized bicycle or moped, motor-driven cycle or19motor scooter, autocycle, cab-enclosed motorcycle, manufactured20home, mobile home, trailer, or semitrailer shall display a21license plate on the rear only.A-22

(b) The owner or operator of a specialty kit car, who pays a fee of one hundred fifty dollars in accordance with rules, shall display a license plate on the rear only. The registrar of motor vehicles shall adopt rules establishing any necessary procedures governing the payment of the fee and implementation of division (A) (1) (b) of this section. The registrar shall pay all fees received under division (A) (1) (b) of this section into the law enforcement assistance fund established under section 109.802 of the Revised Code.

As used in division (A)(1)(b) of this section, "specialty kit car" means a motor vehicle that is assembled by the purchaser or a third party from a set of parts that are produced and sold by a manufacturer.

(c) A motor vehicle that is issued two license plates shall display the validation sticker only on the rear license plate, except that a commercial tractor that does not receive an apportioned license plate under the international registration plan shall display the validation sticker on the front of the commercial tractor. An-

(d) An apportioned vehicle receiving an apportioned42license plate under the international registration plan shall43display the license plate only on the front of a commercial44tractor and on the rear of all other vehicles. All45

(2) All license plates shall be securely fastened so as

not to swing, and shall not be covered by any material that 47 obstructs their visibility. 48 (B) No person to whom a temporary license placard or 49 windshield sticker has been issued for the use of a motor 50 vehicle under section 4503.182 of the Revised Code, and no 51 operator of that motor vehicle, shall fail to display the 52 temporary license placard in plain view from the rear of the 53 vehicle either in the rear window or on an external rear surface 54 of the motor vehicle, or fail to display the windshield sticker 55 in plain view on the rear window of the motor vehicle. No 56 temporary license placard or windshield sticker shall be covered 57 by any material that obstructs its visibility. 58 (B) (C) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor 59 misdemeanor. 60 Section 2. That existing section 4503.21 of the Revised 61 Code is hereby repealed. 62
