BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5.236 and 3345.43 of the Revised	9
Code be enacted to read as follows:	10
Sec. 5.236. The month of April is designated as "Respect	11
Your Date Month" to increase public awareness of dating	12
violence, domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, and rape	13
on college campuses.	14
Sec. 3345.43. (A) (1) Each state institution of higher	15
education, as defined in section 3345.011 of the Revised Code,	16
shall adopt a policy regarding incidents of dating violence	1 7

domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, and rape on campus. 18 The policy shall include the procedure for reporting such 19 incidents and the institutional plan for investigating and 20 responding to such incidents. The policy also shall describe the 21 consequences for committing an incident of dating violence, 2.2 domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, or rape on campus, 2.3 including the institutional disciplinary proceedings and the 24 possible penalties that may be imposed. The institution shall 25 keep a record of all reports of such incidents that it receives. 26 27 Each institution may include other incidents related to dating violence, domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, or 28 rape in the policy adopted under this section. 29 (2) Each policy adopted pursuant to this section shall be 30 developed with the goal of enhancing due process in regard to 31 incidents of dating violence, domestic violence, sexual assault, 32 stalking, and rape on campus and to better define the protocols 33 provided for under the "Clery Act," 20 U.S.C. 1092(f), and Title 34 IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, 20 U.S.C. 1681 et seq. 35 36 (3) Each policy adopted pursuant to this section shall include the definitions listed in division (C) of this section. 37 (B) Each state institution of higher education annually 38 shall distribute copies of the policy adopted pursuant to 39 division (A) of this section during student orientation and at 40 other appropriate events. 41 Additionally, each state institution of higher education 42 shall post copies of the institution's policy in multiple, 43 prominent locations across campus and in a prominent location on 44 the institution's web site. At a minimum, copies posted across 45 campus shall be posted each year during the month of April to 46

Each state institution of higher education may expand upon	59

Section 2. This act shall be known as the "Respect Your	62
Date Act."	63
Section 3. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	64
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	65
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to	66
ensure safety on college campuses across the state for the	67
upcoming academic year. Therefore, this act shall go into	68
immediate effect.	69
