A BILL

To amend section 2131.13 of the Revised Code to	1
allow owners of a motor vehicle, watercraft, or	2
outboard motor who have joint ownership with	3
right of survivorship to transfer title through	4
a transfer-on-death designation.	5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2131.13 of the Revised Code be	6
amended to read as follows:	7
Sec. 2131.13. (A) As used in this section:	8
(1) "Designate or designation in beneficiary form" means	9
to designate, or the designation of, a motor vehicle,	10
watercraft, or outboard motor in a certificate of title that	11
indicates the present owner of the motor vehicle, watercraft, or	12
outboard motor and the intention of the present owner with	13
respect to the transfer of ownership on the present owner's	14
death by designating one or more persons as the beneficiary or	15
beneficiaries who will become the owner or owners of the motor	16
vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor upon the death of the	17
present owner.	18

(2) "Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 19 4505.01 of the Revised Code. 20 (3) "Person" means an individual, a corporation, an 21 organization, or other legal entity. 22 (4) "Transfer-on-death beneficiary or beneficiaries" means 23 a person or persons specified in a certificate of title of a 24 motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor who will become the 25 owner or owners of the motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard 26 motor upon the death of the present owner of the motor vehicle, 27 28 watercraft, or outboard motor. 29 (5) "Watercraft" has the same meaning as in section 1548.01 of the Revised Code. 30 (6) "Owner" includes the plural as well as the singular, 31 as specified in section 1.43 of the Revised Code. 32 (7) "Joint ownership with right of survivorship" has the 33 same meaning as in section 2131.12 of the Revised Code. 34 (B) (1) An individual whose certificate of title of a motor 35 vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor shows sole ownership by 36 that individual may make an application for a certificate of 37 title under section 1548.07 or 4505.06 of the Revised Code to 38 designate that motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor in 39 beneficiary form pursuant to this section. 40 (2) Individuals whose certificate of title of a motor 41 vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor shows joint ownership 42 with right of survivorship may jointly make an application for a 43 certificate of title under section 1548.07 or 4505.06 of the 44 Revised Code to designate that motor vehicle, watercraft, or 45 outboard motor in beneficiary form pursuant to this section. 46

(C) (1) A motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor is
designated in beneficiary form if the certificate of title of
the motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor includes the
name or names of the transfer-on-death beneficiary or
beneficiaries.

(2) The designation of a motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor in beneficiary form is not required to be supported by consideration, and the certificate of title in which the designation is made is not required to be delivered to the transfer-on-death beneficiary or beneficiaries in order for the designation in beneficiary form to be effective.

(D) The designation of a motor vehicle, watercraft, or
outboard motor in beneficiary form may be shown in the
certificate of title by the words "transfer-on-death" or the
abbreviation "TOD" after the name of the owner of a motor
vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor and before the name or
names of the transfer-on-death beneficiary or beneficiaries.

(E) The designation of a transfer-on-death beneficiary or 64 beneficiaries on a certificate of title has no effect on the 65 ownership of a motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor 66 until the death of the owner of the motor vehicle, watercraft, 67 or outboard motor. The owner of a motor vehicle, watercraft, or 68 outboard motor may cancel or change the designation of a 69 transfer-on-death beneficiary or beneficiaries on a certificate 70 of title at any time without the consent of the transfer-on-71 72 death beneficiary or beneficiaries by making an application for a certificate of title under section 1548.07 or 4505.06 of the 73 Revised Code. 74

(F) (1) Upon the death of the owner of a motor vehicle,watercraft, or outboard motor designated in beneficiary form,76

the ownership of the motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard 77 motor shall pass to the transfer-on-death beneficiary or 78 beneficiaries who survive the owner upon transfer of title to 79 the motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor in accordance 80 with section 1548.11 or 4505.10 of the Revised Code. The 81 transfer-on-death beneficiary or beneficiaries who survive the 82 owner may apply for a certificate of title to the motor vehicle, 83 watercraft, or outboard motor upon submitting proof of the death 84 of the owner of the motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard 85 motor. 86

(2) If no transfer-on-death beneficiary or beneficiaries
survive the owner of a motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard
motor, the motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor shall be
included in the probate estate of the deceased owner.

(G) (1) Any transfer of a motor vehicle, watercraft, or
outboard motor to a transfer-on-death beneficiary or
beneficiaries that results from a designation of the motor
vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor in beneficiary form is

not testamentary.

(2) This section does not limit the rights of any creditor

of the owner of a motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard motor

against any transfer-on-death beneficiary or beneficiaries or
98
other transferees of the motor vehicle, watercraft, or outboard

motor under other laws of this state.

(H) (1) This section shall be known and may be cited as the
"Transfer-on-Death of Motor Vehicle, Watercraft, or Outboard
Motor Statute."

(2) Divisions (A) to (H) of this section shall beliberally construed and applied to promote their underlying105

purposes and policy.	106
(3) Unless displaced by particular provisions of divisions	107
(A) to (H) of this section, the principles of law and equity	108
supplement the provisions of those divisions.	109
