A BILL

To enact sections 3727.11, 3727.12, 3727.13,	1
3727.14, 3727.15, and 4765.401 of the Revised	2
Code to provide for recognition of stroke	3
centers and establishment of protocols for	4
assessment, treatment, and transport to	5
hospitals of stroke patients.	6

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3727.11, 3727.12, 3727.13,	7
3727.14, 3727.15, and 4765.401 of the Revised Code be enacted to	8
read as follows:	9
Sec. 3727.11. A hospital shall not represent itself as a	10
comprehensive stroke center, primary stroke center, or acute	11

stroke ready hospital unless it is recognized as such by the	12
department of health under section 3727.13 of the Revised Code.	13
This section does not prohibit a hospital from	14
representing itself as having a relationship or affiliation with	15
a hospital recognized by the department of health under section	16
3727.13 of the Revised Code or a hospital in another state that	17
is certified as a comprehensive stroke center, primary stroke	18
center, or acute stroke ready hospital by an accrediting	19
organization approved by the federal centers for medicare and	20
medicaid services.	21
Sec. 3727.12. (A) A person or government entity seeking	22
recognition of a hospital as a comprehensive stroke center,	23
primary stroke center, or acute stroke ready hospital by the	24
department of health under section 3727.13 of the Revised Code	25
shall file with the department an application for recognition.	26
The application shall be submitted in the manner prescribed by	27
the department.	28
(B)(1) To be eligible for recognition as a comprehensive	29
stroke center under section 3727.13 of the Revised Code, a	30
hospital must be certified as a comprehensive stroke center by	31
an accrediting organization approved by the federal centers for	32
medicare and medicaid services or an organization acceptable to	33
the department under division (C) of this section.	34
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(2) To be eligible for recognition as a primary stroke	35
center under section 3727.13 of the Revised Code, a hospital	36
must be certified as a primary stroke center by an accrediting	37
organization approved by the federal centers for medicare and	38
medicaid services or an organization acceptable to the	39
department under division (C) of this section.	40

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(3) To be eligible for recognition as an acute stroke	41
ready hospital under section 3727.13 of the Revised Code, a	42
hospital must be certified as an acute stroke ready hospital by	43
an accrediting organization approved by the federal centers for	44
medicare and medicaid services or an organization acceptable to	45
the department under division (C) of this section.	46
(C) For purposes of division (B) of this section, to be	47
acceptable to the department an organization must certify	48
comprehensive stroke centers, primary stroke centers, or acute	49
stroke ready hospitals in accordance with nationally recognized	50
certification guidelines.	51
Sec. 3727.13. (A)(1) The department of health shall	52
recognize as a comprehensive stroke center a hospital that	53
satisfies the requirements of division (B)(1) of section 3727.12	54
of the Revised Code and submits a complete application.	55
(2)(a) The department shall recognize as a primary stroke	56
center a hospital that satisfies the requirements of division	57
(B)(2) of section 3727.12 of the Revised Code and submits a	58
complete application.	59
(b) If a hospital satisfying the requirements of division	60
(B) (2) of section 3727.12 of the Revised Code has attained	61
supplementary levels of stroke care distinction as identified by	62
an accrediting organization approved by the federal centers for	63
medicare and medicaid services or an organization accepted by	64
the department under section 3727.12 of the Revised Code,	65
including by offering patients mechanical endovascular therapy,	66
the department shall include that distinction in its	67
recognition.	68
(3) The department shall recognize as an acute stroke	69

ready hospital a hospital that satisfies the requirements of	70
division (B)(3) of section 3727.12 of the Revised Code and	71
submits a complete application.	72
(D) The dependence shall and its researching of a beautal	70
(B) The department shall end its recognition of a hospital	73
made under division (A) of this section if the accrediting	74
organization described in division (B) of section 3727.12 of the	75
Revised Code that certified the hospital revokes, rescinds, or	76
otherwise terminates the hospital's certification with that	77

(C) Not later than the first day of January and July each	79
year, the department shall compile and send a list of hospitals	80
recognized under division (A) of this section to the medical	81
director and cooperating physician advisory board of each	82

4765.01 of the Revised Code. The department also shall maintain	84
a comprehensive list of recognized hospitals on its internet web	85
site and update the list not later than thirty days after a	86
hospital is recognized under division (A) of this section or its	87
recognition ends under division (B) of this section.	88
Sec. 3727.14. If an accrediting organization approved by	89
the federal centers for medicare and medicaid services or an	90
organization that certifies hospitals in accordance with	91
nationally recognized certification guidelines establishes a	92
level of stroke certification that is in addition to the three	93
levels described in sections 3727.11 to 3727.13 of the Revised	94
Code, the department of health shall recognize a hospital_	95
certified at that additional level.	96
For purposes of this section, the department and a	97
hospital shall comply with sections 3727.11 to 3727.13 of the	98
Revised Code as if the certification and recognition described	99

in this section were one of the three levels described in	100
sections 3727.11 to 3727.13 of the Revised Code.	101
Sec. 3727.15. The director of health may adopt rules as	102
the director considers necessary for the implementation of	103
sections 3727.11 to 3727.14 of the Revised Code. The rules shall	104
be adopted in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code.	105
Sec. 4765.401. (A) The medical director or cooperating	106
physician advisory board of each emergency medical service	107
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organization shall establish written protocols for the	
assessment, treatment, and transport to hospitals of stroke	109
patients by emergency medical service personnel. In establishing	110
protocols, the medical director or cooperating physician	111
advisory board shall consult with one or more local hospitals.	112
(B) Each emergency medical service organization shall_	113
provide copies of its protocols to the state board of emergency_	114
medical, fire, and transportation services and the regional	115
director or regional advisory board appointed under section	116
4765.05 of the Revised Code for the organization's emergency	117
