BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3319.2210 of the Revised Code be	5

(D) The state board shall not adopt a rule establishing any additional qualifications for a license issued under this section.

(E) A person that is employed to work in a substitute 64 capacity by a school district or school under this section shall 65 not be employed by a district or school in a non-substitute 66 capacity without satisfying any licensure or permit requirements 67 established in rules adopted by the state board that are 68 applicable to the person's prospective position of employment. 69

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
