BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 166.50 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 166.50. "Microbusiness" means an independently owned	6
and operated for-profit business entity, including any	7
affiliates, that has fewer than twenty full-time employees or	8
full-time equivalent employees and is located in this state.	9
For purposes of this section:	10
(A) "Full-time employee" means an employee who, with	11
respect to a calendar month, is employed an average of at least	12

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thirty hours of service per week.		
(B) The number of full-time equivalent employees for a	14	
calendar month is determined by calculating the aggregate number	15	
of hours of service for that calendar month for employees who	16	
were not full-time employees and dividing that number by one	17	
hundred twenty.	18
