A BILL

To amend section 2923.25 of the Revised Code to
require a 72-hour waiting period between the
purchase and delivery of firearms and to impose
a fine for violating this requirement.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2923.25 of the Revised Code be
amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2923.25. (A) Each federally licensed firearms dealer
who sells any firearm, at the time of the sale of the firearm,
shall offer for sale to the purchaser of the firearm a trigger
lock, gun lock, or gun locking device that is appropriate for
that firearm. Each federally licensed firearms dealer shall post
in a conspicuous location in the dealer's place of business the
poster furnished to the dealer pursuant to section 5502.63 of
the Revised Code and shall make available to all purchasers of
firearms from the dealer the brochure furnished to the dealer
pursuant to that section.

(B) No seller of firearms shall deliver a firearm to a
purchaser until seventy-two hours have elapsed from the date of

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<u>purchase. This division does not apply to sales between</u>	19
<u>federally licensed firearms dealers.</u>	20
<u>(C) Unless the sale is between federally licensed firearms</u>	21
<u>dealers, a seller of firearms who delivers a firearm to a</u>	22
<u>purchaser less than seventy-two hours after the date of purchase</u>	23
<u>shall be subject to a fine equal to the purchase price of the</u>	24
<u>firearm sold.</u>	25
<u>(D) As used in this section, "federally licensed firearms</u>	26
<u>dealer" has the same meaning as in section 5502.63 of the</u>	27
<u>Revised Code.</u>	28
Section 2. That existing section 2923.25 of the Revised	29
Code is hereby repealed.	30
