A BILL

To amend section 2923.25 of the Revised Code to 1
require a 72-hour waiting period between the 2
purchase and delivery of firearms and to impose 3
a fine for violating this requirement. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2923.25 of the Revised Code be 5
amended to read as follows: 6

Sec. 2923.25. (A) Each federally licensed firearms dealer 7
who sells any firearm, at the time of the sale of the firearm, 8
shall offer for sale to the purchaser of the firearm a trigger 9
lock, gun lock, or gun locking device that is appropriate for 10
that firearm. Each federally licensed firearms dealer shall post 11
in a conspicuous location in the dealer's place of business the 12
poster furnished to the dealer pursuant to section 5502.63 of 13
the Revised Code and shall make available to all purchasers of 14
firearms from the dealer the brochure furnished to the dealer 15
pursuant to that section. 16

(B) No seller of firearms shall deliver a firearm to a 17
purchaser until seventy-two hours have elapsed from the date of 18

purchase. This division does not apply to sales between 19
federally licensed firearms dealers. 20

(C) Unless the sale is between federally licensed firearms 21
dealers, a seller of firearms who delivers a firearm to a 22
purchaser less than seventy-two hours after the date of purchase 23
shall be subject to a fine equal to the purchase price of the 24
firearm sold. 25

(D) As used in this section, "federally licensed firearms 26
dealer" has the same meaning as in section 5502.63 of the 27
Revised Code. 28

Section 2. That existing section 2923.25 of the Revised 29
Code is hereby repealed. 30
