A BILL

To enact section 5.2510 of the Revised Code to 1
designate January 31 as "Omphalocele Awareness 2
Day." 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.2510 of the Revised Code be 4
enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 5.2510. The thirty-first day of January is designated 6
as "Omphalocele Awareness Day" to raise public awareness and 7
encourage medical research on this birth defect. 8
