# AN ACT

To enact section 5.236 of the Revised Code to designate July 8 as "Harrison Dillard Day."

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:*

SECTION 1. That section 5.236 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5.236. The eighth day of July is designated as "Harrison Dillard Day," to commemorate the four-time Olympic champion's accomplishments in earning gold medals in the 1948 and 1952 Summer Olympics. Harrison Dillard won Olympic medals in both sprinting and hurdles.
