## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3318.39 of the Revised Code be	7
enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 3318.39. (A) The Ohio school facilities commission	9
shall establish a program under which, beginning on December 31,	10
2017, school districts that have not yet received assistance	11
under the classroom facilities assistance program may apply for	12
and receive state funds to use for technology and physical	13
alterations to improve technology infrastructure or school	14
safety and security.	15
The commission shall adopt guidelines and procedures for	16
the administration of the program. The guidelines shall include	17
the following:	18

(1) A requirement that, in order to participate in the	19	
program, the district's board of education must approve	20	
participation by an affirmative vote of not less than four-	21	
fifths of the board's full membership;		
(2) The application process for districts and the process	23	
by which the commission annually shall select districts for	24	
assistance under the program;		
(3) The method for determining the amount of funding	26	
awards under the program, including any requirements relating to		
the state's portion and the district's portion of the basic		
project cost, if applicable.		
(B) If a district participates in the program established	30	
under this section, that district shall no longer be eligible	31	
for participation in the classroom facilities assistance	32	
program.
