The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Reineke was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 51 - Representative Faber.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Brinkman, Butler, Dean, Dever, DeVitis, Green, Goodman, Hagan, Henne, Keller, Kick, Koehler, Lipps, Merrin, Retherford, Riedel, Roegner, Romanchuk, Scherer, Stein, Thompson, Vitale, Young.

To amend section 117.46 and to enact sections 101.88, 101.881, 101.882, and 101.89 of the Revised Code to require standing committees of the General Assembly to establish a schedule for the periodic review and sunset of state departments that are currently in the Governor's cabinet, and to require that Auditor of State performance audits be scheduled to coincide with the periodic review.

H. B. No. 52 - Representative Rezabek.

To amend section 1345.99 and to enact section 1345.023 of the Revised Code to regulate the solicitation of certain deeds.

H. B. No. 53 - Representative Becker.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hood, Brinkman, Dean, Thompson, Vitale, Goodman, Riedel, Roegner, Merrin, Antani, Zeltwanger, Keller.

To amend sections 9.81, 121.40, 124.14, 124.15, 3345.31, 4117.03, 4117.04, 4117.05, 4117.09, 4117.10, 4117.11, 4121.03, 4121.121, 4121.69, and 5501.20 of the Revised Code to remove any requirement under the Public Employees Collective Bargaining Law that public employees join or pay dues to any employee organization, to prohibit public employees from requiring public employees to join or pay dues to any employee organization, to prohibit an employee organization from being required to represent public employees who are not members of the employee organization, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 54 - Representatives Blessing, Gavarone. Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Bishoff, Arndt, Riedel, Hambley, Young, Thompson, Smith, R., Householder.

To enact sections 158.01, 158.02, 158.03, 158.04, 158.05, 158.06, 158.07, 158.08, 158.09, 158.10, and 158.11 of the Revised Code to authorize the Treasurer of State to issue revenue obligations of the state for the purpose of making loans to qualifying public entities for their acquisition of permanent improvements through the Treasurer of State's purchase of public obligations of those qualifying entities.

H. B. No. 55 - Representative Rogers.

To enact section 5534.38 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route Two in Lake County as the "Lcpl Bret M. Poklar Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 56 - Representatives Dever, Gavarone.

To amend sections 2951.041 and 2953.38 and to enact section 2953.521 of the Revised Code to permit a person who is found not guilty or is the defendant in a dismissed case to apply for an expungement of the person's records in the case if the complaint, indictment, or finding of not guilty resulted from the applicant having been a victim of human trafficking, to permit a person convicted of certain prostitution-related offenses to apply for the expungement of any record of conviction of an offense, with certain exceptions, if the person's participation in the offense was a result of having been a victim of human trafficking, and to authorize intervention in lieu of conviction for persons charged with committing an offense while a victim of compelling prostitution.

H. B. No. 57 - Representatives Boccieri, Ramos.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, and 3328.24 and to enact sections 3313.461, 3345.90, and 3781.181 of the Revised Code to require the use of domestic steel in construction, repair, or improvement projects involving certain buildings used by public schools, state institutions of higher education, and specified private colleges.

H. B. No. 58 - Representatives Brenner, Slaby. Cosponsors: Representatives Perales, Zeltwanger, Vitale, Hambley, Conditt, Young, Roegner, Riedel, Thompson, Dean, Cupp, Keller, Blessing.

To amend section 3313.60 of the Revised Code to require instruction in cursive handwriting.

H. B. No. 59 - Representatives Leland, West. Cosponsors: Representatives Ramos, Brenner, Cera, Romanchuk, Thompson, Boggs, Rogers, Johnson, G., Boyd, Craig, Kent, Riedel, Smith, K., Faber, Sykes, Sheehy, Arndt, Fedor, Ashford.

To enact section 5.242 of the Revised Code to designate October 7 as "Moses Fleetwood Walker Day."

H. B. No. 60 - Representatives Hambley, Rogers. Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Sheehy, Becker, Retherford, Thompson, Stein.

To amend sections 4506.01, 4506.11, 4507.01, 4507.13, and 4507.52 and to enact sections 4506.072, 4507.021, 4507.061, and 4507.511 of the Revised Code to authorize the issuance of an enhanced driver's license, enhanced commercial driver's license, and enhanced identification card to facilitate land and sea border crossings between the United States and Canada and Mexico, pursuant to an agreement with the United States Department of Homeland Security.
