INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 289 - Representatives Hood, McColley.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brenner, Thompson, Becker, Brinkman, Riedel, Dean, Goodman, Keller, Lipps.

To enact sections 101.62, 101.63, 101.64, 101.65, 103.26, 103.27, 107.56, 4798.01, 4798.02, and 4798.03 of the Revised Code to establish a statewide policy on occupational regulation, to require standing committees of the General Assembly to periodically review occupational licensing boards regarding their sunset, to require the Common Sense Initiative Office to review certain actions taken by occupational licensing boards, and to require the Legislative Service Commission to perform assessments of occupational licensing bills and state regulation of occupations.

H. B. No. 290 - Representative Blessing.

To amend sections 4501.21 and 4503.772 and to enact section 4503.908 of the Revised Code to create the St. Xavier High School license plate.

H. B. No. 291 - Representative Wiggam.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lipps, Seitz, Arndt, Merrin, Goodman, Dean, Stein, Henne.

To enact sections 307.442, 505.604, and 701.02 of the Revised Code to authorize counties, townships, and municipal corporations to purchase an employee dishonesty and faithful performance of duty insurance policy, instead of a bond, for protection from loss due to the fraudulent or dishonest actions of, and the failure to perform a duty prescribed by law by, an officer, official, employee, or appointee for which a bond is required by law.

Said bills were considered the first time.
