The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Ryan was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 337 - Representative Duffey.

To amend sections 5739.02 and 5739.03 of the Revised Code to exempt from sales and use tax textbooks purchased by post-secondary students.

H. B. No. 338 - Representative Ginter.

To amend section 3327.10 of the Revised Code regarding medical examinations for school bus drivers.

H. B. No. 339 - Representatives Schaffer, Hagan.

To amend sections 715.27, 3781.102, 4740.01, 4740.03, 4740.04, 4740.05, 4740.06, 4740.07, 4740.11, 4740.12, 4740.13, 4740.14, and 4740.16 of the Revised Code to license residential only construction contractors and to make changes to the law regulating specialty construction contractors.

H. B. No. 340 - Representative Young.

To amend sections 5101.27, 5101.99, 5160.45, 5160.46, and 5160.99 and to enact sections 5101.271, 5160.451, and 5167.15 of the Revised Code regarding the release of information concerning public and medical assistance recipients.

H. B. No. 341 - Representatives Huffman, Cera.

To amend sections 149.43 and 149.45 of the Revised Code to include judges as individuals whose residential and familial information is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Law, and whose addresses public offices, upon request, must redact from records available to the general public on the internet.

To amend section 5715.19 of the Revised Code to require local governments that contest property values to formally pass an authorizing resolution for each contest and to notify property owners.

Said bills were considered the first time.
