The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Butler was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 417** - Representative Anielski.

To amend sections 4501.21 and 4503.772 and to enact section 4503.873 of the Revised Code to create the "Padua Franciscan High School" license plate.

**H. B. No. 418** - Representative Ingram.

Cosponsors: Representatives Ashford, Brenner, Kent, Lepore-Hagan, Reece, West.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, and 3328.24 and to enact section 3319.324 of the Revised Code to require a public or chartered nonpublic school to transmit a student's records within five business days when the student transfers to another school.

**H. B. No. 419** - Representative Henne.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lang, Riedel, Sprague.

To amend section 2744.02 of the Revised Code to modify the defense to the liability of a member of a police or fire department or emergency medical service of a political subdivision for the negligent operation of a motor vehicle in response to an emergency by requiring that the vehicle has its lights and sirens simultaneously activated.

**H. B. No. 420** - Representatives Sykes, Boyd.

Cosponsors: Representatives Bocchieri, Ashford, Antonio, LaTourette, Lepore-Hagan, Ginter, Smith, K., Sprague, Howse, Riedel, Boggs, Kent, Carfagna, Kick, West, Sheehy.

To enact section 5.2314 of the Revised Code to designate the month of November as Ohio Adoption Awareness Month.

**H. B. No. 421** - Representatives Patterson, Becker.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lepore-Hagan, Seitz, Ashford, Boggs.

To enact section 4505.072 of the Revised Code to provide that when a

certificate of title is issued for a motor vehicle, the owner may request that the certificate indicate that the motor vehicle is a replica vehicle.

**H. B. No. 422** - Representatives Ginter, Rogers.

Cosponsors: Representatives Carfagna, Seitz, Sprague, Thompson.

To amend section 4909.05 and to enact sections 4905.481, 4905.49, 4905.491, 4909.051, 4909.052, 4909.053, 4909.054, 4909.055, 4909.057, and 4909.059 of the Revised Code to govern acquisitions of municipal water-works and sewage disposal system companies by certain larger nonmunicipal water-works or sewage disposal system companies.

**H. B. No. 423** - Representatives Lang, Seitz.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Faber, Green, Riedel, Young.

To enact section 2917.14 of the Revised Code to create the crime of masked intimidation, a misdemeanor of the first degree.

**H. B. No. 424** - Representative Wiggam.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Riedel, Lang, Thompson, Roegner, Koehler.

To amend sections 4141.28 and 4141.29 and to enact section 4141.294 of the Revised Code to enact the "Substance Recovery and Workforce Improvement Act" regarding drug testing and eligibility for unemployment compensation benefits.

**H. B. No. 425** - Representatives Antani, Craig.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Seitz, Sheehy, Lang.

To amend sections 149.43 and 149.433 of the Revised Code to provide that specified portions of peace officers' body-worn camera recordings and the infrastructure record of a public school are not public records for purposes of the Public Records Law.

**H. B. No. 426** - Representative Hagan.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Dean, Riedel, Vitale, Thompson, Keller, Hood, Brenner, Fedor, Rezabek.

To amend section 2907.03 of the Revised Code to prohibit an employee of a school or institution of higher education who is not in a position of authority from engaging in sexual conduct with certain students.

Said bills were considered the first time.
