Prior to the end of fiscal year 2019, the Director shall determine the available balance in Fund 5TZ0 and transfer the lesser of the available balance in Fund 5TZ0 or cash equal to the amount previously transferred to Fund 5TZ0 from the General Revenue Fund back to the General Revenue Fund."
