The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Brenner was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills and joint resolution were introduced:

H. B. No. 443 - Representative Sweeney.

To amend section 3313.60 of the Revised Code to require school district boards of education to incorporate mental health instruction into their health education curricula.

H. B. No. 444 - Representative Sweeney.

To amend section 3717.45 of the Revised Code to require a seasonal food service operation license fee to be one-half of the license fee for a food service operation that is not a seasonal food service operation.

H. B. No. 445 - Representative Riedel.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antonio, Thompson.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.734 of the Revised Code to create the "Patrol Supporter" license plate.

H. B. No. 446 - Representatives Rogers, Seitz.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antonio, Becker, Boccieri, Celebrezze, Fedor, Kent, Sheehy, Smith, K.

To enact section 1337.261 of the Revised Code relative to the acceptance of an acknowledged power of attorney.

H. B. No. 447 - Representative Reece.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.765 of the Revised Code to create the "Amaranth Grand Chapter Order of the Eastern Star" license plate.

H. B. No. 448 - Representatives LaTourette, Boyd.

Cosponsors: Representatives Boggs, Howse, Reineke, Rezabek, Smith, K., West.

To amend sections 2151.411, 3107.15, 3109.051, 3109.11, and 3113.31 and to enact sections 3109.18, 3109.181, 3109.182, 3109.183, and 3109.90 of the

Revised Code to create sibling visitation rights, to make changes to the law regarding sibling placement by a court or agency and sibling relationships when parental rights are terminated, and to extend the sibling relationship beyond adoption.

H. B. No. 449 - Representatives Rogers, Patterson.

To amend section 3314.021 of the Revised Code to require the Department of Education to attribute any community school sponsor ratings an entity received during its relationship with a state university board of trustees to that entity even if it no longer has a relationship with the university.

H. B. No. 450 - Representative Antani.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Lang, Thompson.

To amend section 3901.88 and to enact sections 3901.881, 3901.882, 3901.883, 3901.884, 3901.886, 3901.887, and 3901.888 of the Revised Code to impose review and other requirements on existing health insurance mandated benefits and to establish requirements for the creation of new mandated benefits.

H. J. R. No. 6 - Representative Sweeney.

Proposing to amend Section 2 of Article II and Section 9 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to impose term limits prohibiting a person from holding office longer than eight years in the Ohio Senate, eight years in the Ohio House of Representatives, and more than sixteen years in total in the General Assembly.

Said bills and joint resolution were considered the first time.
