The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Romanchuk was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 554** - Representative Seitz.

To enact section 153.81 of the Revised Code to regulate the use of indemnity provisions in professional design contracts related to public improvements.

**H. B. No. 555** - Representatives West, Sykes.

Cosponsors: Representatives Rogers, Seitz, Celebrezze, Brown, Kent, Howse, Smith, K., Ashford, Antonio, Reece, Boggs.

To amend section 1.58 and to enact section 109.67 of the Revised Code to provide that a reduction of a penalty, forfeiture, or punishment for an offense applies with respect to an offender who committed that offense on or after the bill's effective date or, if the offense is not an offense of violence, prior to that date and was sentenced for the offense under the law in effect prior to the reduction.

**H. B. No. 556** - Representative Ramos.

Cosponsors: Representatives Cera, Boggs, Sheehy, Lepore-Hagan, Kent, Smith, K.

To enact sections 3333.101 and 3333.102 of the Revised Code to create the Frances Lewandowski Memorial Medical Research Fund and the Medical University Research Reserve Fund to provide grants to colleges for research on terminal or incurable diseases and to make an appropriation.

**H. B. No. 557** - Representative Anielski.

Cosponsors: Representatives Schuring, Reineke, Brenner, Antonio, Barnes, Kelly, Lepore-Hagan, Patmon, Sweeney.

To amend sections 109.572, 1701.03, 1705.03, 1705.04, 1705.53, 1785.01, 1785.02, 1785.03, 1785.08, 4723.16, 4725.33, 4729.161, 4731.07, 4731.071, 4731.226, 4731.24, 4731.25, 4731.65, 4732.28, 4734.17, 4755.111, 4755.471, 4757.37, 4776.01, and 4776.20 and to enact sections 4785.01, 4785.02,

4785.03, 4785.04, 4785.05, 4785.06, 4785.07, 4785.08, 4785.09, 4785.10, 4785.11, 4785.12, 4785.13, 4785.14, and 4785.99 of the Revised Code to require the licensure of art therapists and to require the State Medical Board to regulate the licensure and practice of art therapists.

**H. B. No. 558** - Representative McClain.

To amend section 955.011 of the Revised Code to exempt certain disabled veterans from paying a dog registration fee when application is made to the county auditor that includes proof that the dog is an assistance dog.

**H. B. No. 559** - Representatives Gonzales, Landis.

Cosponsors: Representatives Slaby, Cera, Ingram.

To amend sections 3301.53, 3313.67, 3313.671, and 5104.014 and to enact sections 3701.1310 and 3701.1311 of the Revised Code to make changes to the law governing immunization of children enrolled in school, preschool programs, and day-care programs.

**H. B. No. 560** - Representative Lanese.

To amend sections 923.41, 923.48, and 923.51 of the Revised Code to prohibit pet food from containing remains from an animal that was euthanized by the use of any drug injected intravenously or through another nonvascular route or remains from any dog or cat.
