The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Pelanda was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 586** - Representatives Cera, Rogers.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antonio, Sykes, Celebrezze, O'Brien, Holmes, Kelly, Lepore-Hagan, Ingram, West.

To amend sections 323.151, 323.152, 323.153, 323.157, 4503.064, 4503.065, and 4503.066 of the Revised Code to remove the income limit that restricts eligibility for the homestead exemption and to increase the exemption amount from \$25,000 to \$30,000.

**H. B. No. 587** - Representatives Anielski, Kick.

To enact section 5164.061 of the Revised Code to require Ohio's Medicaid program to cover white canes for blind or visually impaired recipients.

To enact section 5534.91 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of Interstate Route 71 in Franklin County as the "James H. Hough Memorial Highway."

To enact section 5.49 of the Revised Code to designate September 15 to October 15 each year as "Hispanic and Latino Heritage Month."

**H. B. No. 590** - Representatives Vitale, Keller.

To amend sections 2307.601, 2901.05, and 2901.09 and to enact sections 2901.091 and 2901.092 of the Revised Code to define what constitutes reasonable force and specify when a person is justified in its use or threatened use, to provide that a person has no duty to retreat from any place where the person is lawfully present prior to using or threatening to use reasonable force, to establish civil and criminal immunity for a person who uses or threatens to use reasonable force, to revise the circumstances under which a person who uses or threatens to use deadly force is presumed to be acting in self-defense or in defense of another, and to establish a procedure and standards for asserting and disproving self-defense, defense of another, or defense of a residence in a criminal or civil case.

To amend sections 3301.0710, 3301.0711, 3301.0714, 3301.0715, 3301.52, 3301.81, 3302.01, 3302.02, 3302.03, 3302.033, 3302.036, 3302.04, 3302.05, 3302.063, 3302.10, 3302.12, 3302.13, 3302.15, 3302.151, 3302.21, 3302.22, 3310.03, 3311.741, 3311.80, 3313.413, 3313.618, 3313.6113, 3313.903, 3314.012, 3314.015, 3314.016, 3314.017, 3314.02, 3314.03, 3314.034, 3314.05, 3314.085, 3314.35, 3317.0216, 3319.111, 3319.112, 3324.05, 3326.17, 3326.41, 3328.26, 3333.041, 3333.048, and 3333.391; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 3302.03 (3302.032); to enact new section 3302.03; and to repeal sections 3302.031, 3302.032, 3302.034, 3302.035, and 3314.37 of the Revised Code to revise the state report card rating system for school districts and public schools.
