The House met pursuant to adjournment.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills and joint resolution were introduced:

H. B. No. 638 - Representative Kent.

To amend section 2901.13 of the Revised Code to modify the period of limitation for prosecution of offenses involving child abuse and neglect.

H. B. No. 639 - Representative Dean.

To enact section 5534.431 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 123 in Warren County as the "Officer Ciera N. Greene Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 640 - Representative Sheehy.

Cosponsors: Representatives Sweeney, Ashford, Riedel, Ramos, Brown, O'Brien, Romanchuk, Patterson, Hoops, Kent, Seitz.

To enact section 5534.812 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of Interstate Route 475 in Lucas County as the "Sgt. Alex Drabik Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 641 - Representative Antani.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Lang, Riedel, Hood.

To amend section 5739.02 of the Revised Code to exempt from sales and use tax things purchased by an interstate logistics business and used primarily to move completed manufactured products to the point from which they are shipped from a manufacturing facility and related power sources.

H. B. No. 642 - Representative Gonzales.

Cosponsor: Representative Brinkman.

To amend sections 3715.63, 4729.16, and 4729.37 and to enact sections 3715.75 and 4729.371 of the Revised Code to classify as adulterated a nonprescription diabetes test device that was not purchased or acquired directly from the device's manufacturer or an authorized distributor, to establish recordkeeping and other requirements for pharmacists who dispense nonprescription diabetes test devices, and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 643 - Representatives Arndt, Patterson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Schuring, Reineke, Hill, Gavarone, Stein, Manning, Hoops, West.

To amend section 154.22 of the Revised Code and to amend Sections 211.10 and 211.20 of Am. Sub. H.B. 49 of the 132nd General Assembly and Sections 207.230, 207.440, 215.10, 223.10, 223.40, and 223.50 of H.B. 529 of the 132nd General Assembly to allow equipment for the protection and preservation of Lake Erie to be purchased with proceeds from the Parks and Recreation Improvement Fund and to appropriate funds for projects enhancing water quality in the Western Lake Erie Basin.

H. J. R. No. 16 - Representatives Arndt, Patterson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Schuring, Reineke, Hill, Gavarone, Hambley, Manning, Hoops.

Proposing to enact Section 2t of Article VIII of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to permit the issuance of general obligation bonds to fund clean water improvements.

Said bills and joint resolution were considered the first time.
