INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 704 - Representative Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Representatives Koehler, Retherford, Becker, Hood, Antani, Blessing.

To amend sections 4141.28 and 4141.29 and to enact section 4141.294 of the Revised Code to require applicants for unemployment benefits to submit to a drug test under certain circumstances, to require the Director of Job and Family Services to operate an Ohio Works First drug testing pilot program, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 705 - Representatives Hambley, Ingram.

Cosponsors: Representatives Scherer, Hill, Riedel, Seitz, Speaker Smith.

To amend sections 3313.25, 3313.31, and 3319.36 of the Revised Code regarding the circumstances in which school district and educational service center treasurers may be held liable for a loss of public funds.

Said bills were considered the first time.
