INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 719 - Representative Pelanda.

To enact section 109.67 of the Revised Code to require the Attorney General to create and maintain a statewide tracking system for the processing of sexual assault examination kits.

H. B. No. 720 - Representatives Antani, Smith, T.

To amend sections 305.31, 5739.021, 5739.022, and 5739.026 of the Revised Code to require voter approval of any increase in the rate of a county sales tax.

H. B. No. 721 - Representative Riedel.

Cosponsors: Speaker Smith, Representatives Gavarone, Lipps, Ryan, Antani, Romanchuk, Carfagna, Thompson, Lanese, Antonio, Lang, Scherer, Schaffer, Patterson, Miller, Hoops, Faber, Reineke, McClain, Sprague, Cupp.

To enact section 5.51 of the Revised Code to designate the week that includes July 20th as "One Small Step Week."

Said bills were considered the first time.
