INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 729 - Representative Arndt.

To enact section 5534.98 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 53 in Ottawa County as the "Catawba Island Township Veterans Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 730 - Representative Ramos.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lepore-Hagan, West, Ashford, Howse, Patterson, Smith, K., Miller.

To amend section 3704.03 of the Revised Code to require all rules adopted by the Director of Environmental Protection governing the fabrication, manufacturing, usage, and disposal of asbestos, asbestos-containing materials, and asbestos-containing products to be consistent with the United States Environmental Protection Agency regulations governing asbestos as those regulations existed on August 1, 2018.

Said bills were considered the first time.
