INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 731 - Representative Hoops.

Cosponsors: Representatives Riedel, Green.

To amend sections 107.03, 5703.48, and 5703.95 of the Revised Code to require the Tax Commissioner's biennial tax expenditure report to include information on property tax exemptions and to require the Tax Expenditure Review Committee to periodically review each property tax exemption.

H. B. No. 732 - Representatives Pelanda, Arndt.

Cosponsors: Representatives Koehler, Gavarone, Patterson, Boggs, Lanese, Carfagna.

To enact section 173.041 of the Revised Code to establish dementia training requirements for long-term services and supports providers.

H. B. No. 733 - Representative Perales.

Cosponsors: Representatives Butler, Edwards, Henne, Hill, Lang, O'Brien, Patterson, Riedel, Smith, K.

To amend section 4123.026 of the Revised Code to require the Administrator of Workers' Compensation or a self-insuring public employer to pay for services used to determine whether a person employed by a detention facility sustained an injury or occupational disease after exposure to another person's blood or bodily fluids under specified circumstances.

Said bills were considered the first time.
