INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 742 - Representative Brinkman.

Cosponsor: Representative Becker.

To enact section 4511.433 of the Revised Code to require drivers to yield the right of way to any other vehicle that is attempting to park or exit either an angled parking space or a parallel parking space on a public road.

H. B. No. 743 - Representative Perales.

Cosponsors: Representatives Butler, Johnson, Retherford, Wiggam, Young.

To amend section 5901.11 and to enact section 5901.10 of the Revised Code to authorize county veterans service commissions to make contributions to public entities or nonprofit corporations for programs of outreach and coordination to enhance available veterans' services.

H. B. No. 744 - Representatives Young, Hambley.

Cosponsors: Representatives Henne, Kick, Retherford.

To enact section 3901.80 of the Revised Code to prohibit insurers from discriminating against living organ donors.

Said bills were considered the first time.
