INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 753 - Representative Antani.

To amend section 5739.02 of the Revised Code to exempt from sales and use tax the sale of diapers designed for infants and toddlers.

H. B. No. 754 - Representative Brinkman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Gavarone, Romanchuk, Greenspan, LaTourette.

To amend sections 959.132 and 959.99 and to enact section 959.30 of the Revised Code to prohibit an animal abuse offender from owning, possessing, having custody of, or residing with a companion animal for a specified time period.

H. B. No. 755 - Representatives Brinkman, Lanese.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Gavarone, Romanchuk, Greenspan, LaTourette.

To amend section 2953.32 and to enact sections 959.30, 959.31, 959.32, 959.33, and 959.34 of the Revised Code to require the Attorney General to establish an animal abuser registry.

Said bills were considered the first time.
