The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to Senate Rule No. 3, the Clerk called the Senate to order.

Senator Oelslager was selected to preside according to the rule.

The journal of the last legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 30 - Senator Eklund.

Cosponsors: Senators Huffman, Terhar, Yuko, Williams, Hoagland, Beagle.

To enact section 305.50 of the Revised Code to authorize counties to adopt resolutions regulating motor vehicle traffic on county and township roads.

S. B. No. 31 - Senator Eklund.

Cosponsors: Senators Terhar, Hottinger, Huffman, Hoagland.

To enact section 3718.026 of the Revised Code to authorize a board of county commissioners or municipal legislative authority to elect to withdraw the county or municipal corporation from the application of any rule adopted by the Department of Health after January 1, 2014, that governs the design of household sewage treatment systems.

S. B. No. 32 - Senator Eklund.

Cosponsors: Senators Coley, Hoagland.

To amend sections 2945.71 and 2945.73 of the Revised Code to provide a prosecutor an additional fourteen days to commence a trial after a person charged with a felony has been discharged because the person has not been brought to trial within the required amount of time and to authorize the court to release the person from detention in connection with those charges pending trial.

S. B. No. 33 - Senator Eklund.

Cosponsors: Senators Huffman, Terhar, Yuko, Williams, Skindell, Hoagland, Hite, Bacon.

To amend sections 2913.04 and 2923.129 and to enact section 5503.101 of the Revised Code to allow disclosure of information from the law enforcement automated data system (LEADS) to a defendant in a traffic or criminal case.

S. B. No. 34 - Senator Manning.

Cosponsors: Senators Bacon, Hoagland, Williams, Yuko.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3317.01, 3326.11, and 3328.24 and to enact section 3313.621 of the Revised Code to generally require public and chartered nonpublic schools to open for instruction after Labor Day.

S. B. No. 35 - Senator Skindell.

Cosponsors: Senators Schiavoni, Thomas, Brown, Tavares.

To amend sections 5747.71 and 5747.98 of the Revised Code to remove the income restriction on the earned income tax credit and to make the credit refundable beginning in 2017.
