The following bill was introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 171 - Senator Hottinger.

Cosponsors: Senators Gardner, Eklund, Lehner, Beagle.

To amend section 2919.27 of the Revised Code to increase the penalty that applies to the offense of violating a protection order under certain circumstances and to require electronic monitoring of those convicted of violating certain protection orders to be carried out by probation agencies.
